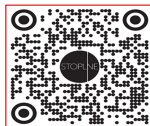

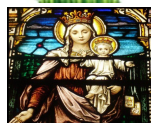

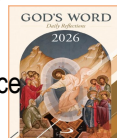

REPLACEMENT OF CHURCH DOORS

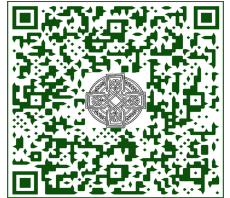
