9. IRELAND'S EASTER RISING 1916 - you are invited to attend a short ceremony on **Easter Monday, 6 April, at Nudgee Cemetery**, where we will commemorate the bravery of William (Dan) Ryan. William, or Bill as he was known to friends in Brisbane, fought as a volunteer in the Dublin GPO during the Easter Week 1916 Rising and later in Ireland's War of Independence. He migrated to Brisbane in 1926 and died after a long illness in 1958. He had worked as a barman for a substantial period of time in the Alliance Hotel in Spring Hill. We will gather at 10.00am at his gravesite for our short ceremony. Please come and pay tribute to someone who bravely stepped forward to help Ireland on the road to independence.

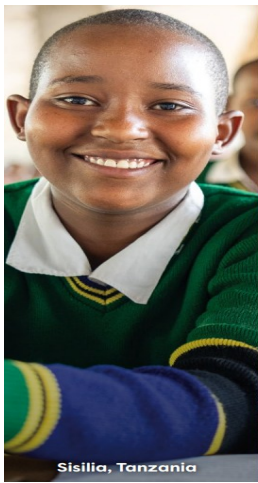
