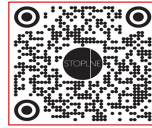

PERSECUTION & FAITH: A WITNESS OF COURAGE AND FORGIVENESS FROM PAKISTAN -Twenty-year-old Akash Bashir was serving as a volunteer security guard at his parish in Lahore, Pakistan, when a terrorist with explosives tried to enter the church. Akash said, "I would rather die than let you in," and then gave his life to prevent a massacre. In the years since, his parents have offered an extraordinary witness of Christian faith. Asked whether they had forgiven those responsible for their son's death, they replied: "Yes, we have forgiven them and pray that they may find the right path to God." Their example reminds us that the Gospel calls us not only to courage, but also to forgiveness. **Reflection:** Where may God be asking you to make a sacrifice out of love, or to forgive an injustice against you?
