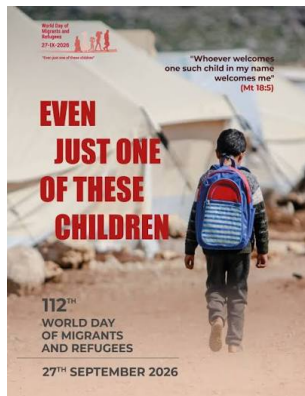

Helping our sisters and brothers in Bitokara, Papua New Guinea

Five years ago, we established a relationship with the Catholic Parish of Bitokara, an extremely poor and remote parish, 565 km northeast of Port Moresby in West New Britain, PNG.

We regularly pray for them, and parishioners of St Flannan's have been generous in their financial support for essential projects in Bitokara. Parishioners have provided support for a parishioner to study nursing, solar panels for a health centre and water tanks and associated structures for a village in a parish where people walked up to four kilometres in hilly country to fetch water for drinking and cleaning and in 2023, to build a Meeting House for the Legion of Mary and other church groups in the village of Ganeboku.

We are now asking your support to assist the people to build a new church for Bitokara.
