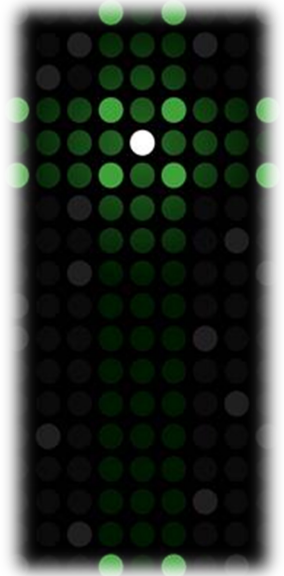

Course runs over four sessions: October 9, October 16, October 23, October 30.

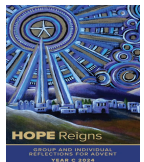
Each session will run twice: at 9.30am – 11am, and repeated at 7pm – 8.30pm.
